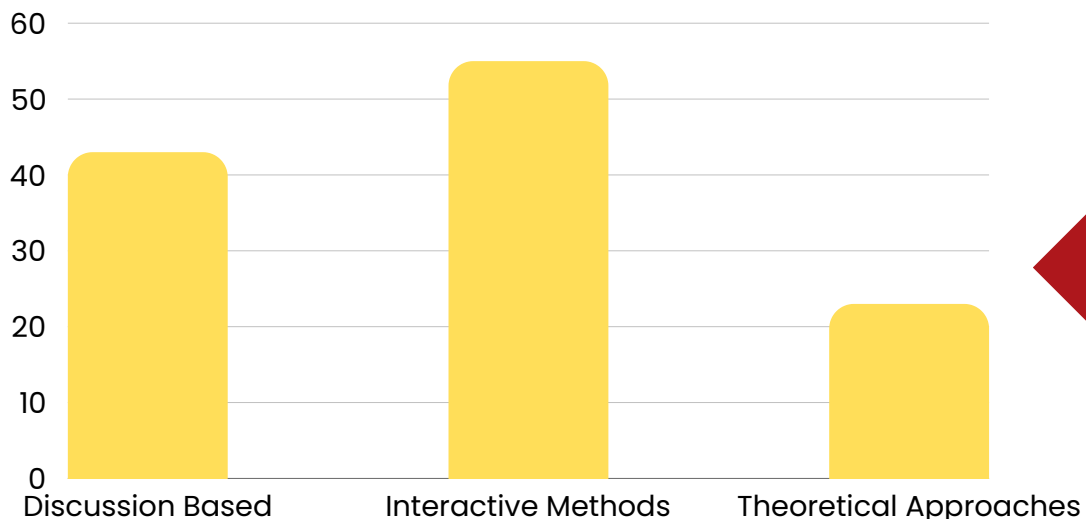

# Insights from BRISWA 2.0 *Survey*

The analysis of the BRISWA 2.0 survey results is providing valuable insights into effective strategies for teaching about racism. A word frequency analysis of responses to the question on teaching strategies revealed clear trends:



- **Discussion-Based Methods:** A strong preference emerged for open dialogues and conversations as a central approach to teaching about racism, reflecting the value of active engagement and critical thinking.
- **Interactive Methods:** These were highlighted as an equally important strategy, emphasizing the effectiveness of participatory and engaging teaching techniques.
- **Theoretical Approaches:** While mentioned less frequently, structured academic frameworks remain an integral part of the conversation, offering depth and rigor in addressing the topic.

These findings emphasize the importance of dynamic and dialogic educational strategies in fostering understanding and addressing racism effectively. Further analysis will guide the development of actionable tools and materials to support educators and students alike.
