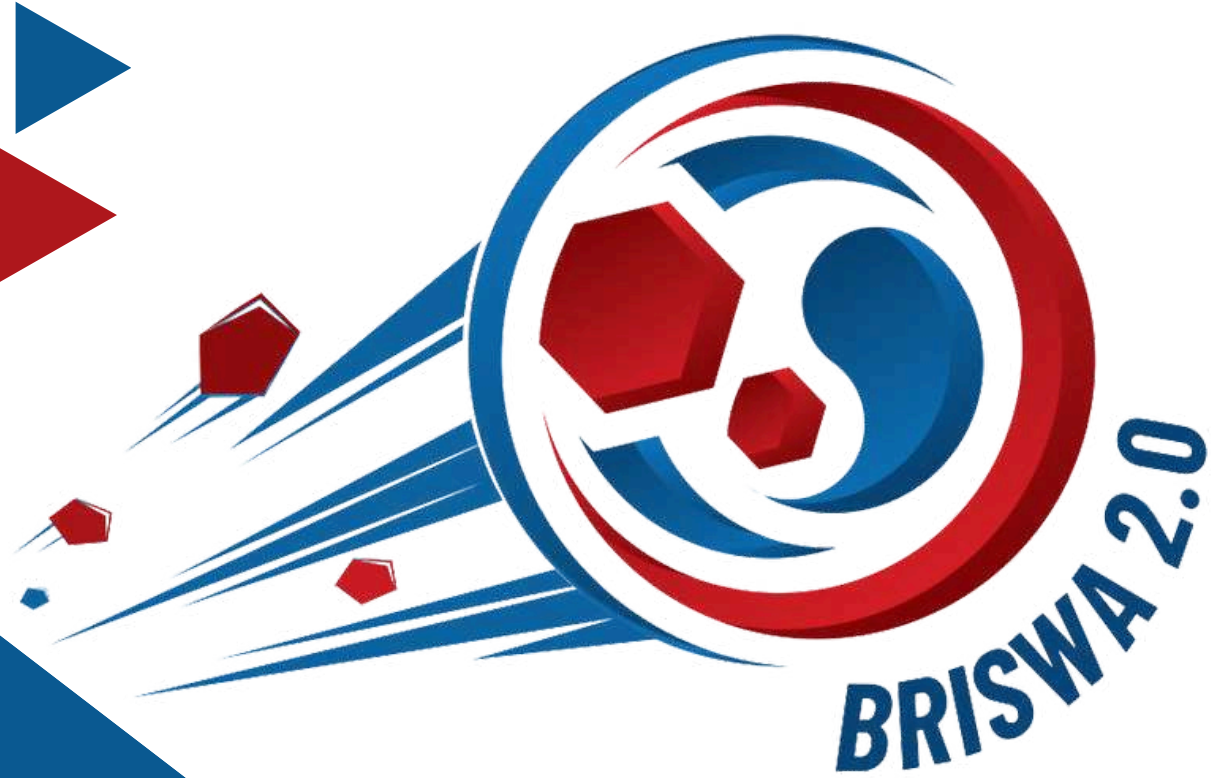

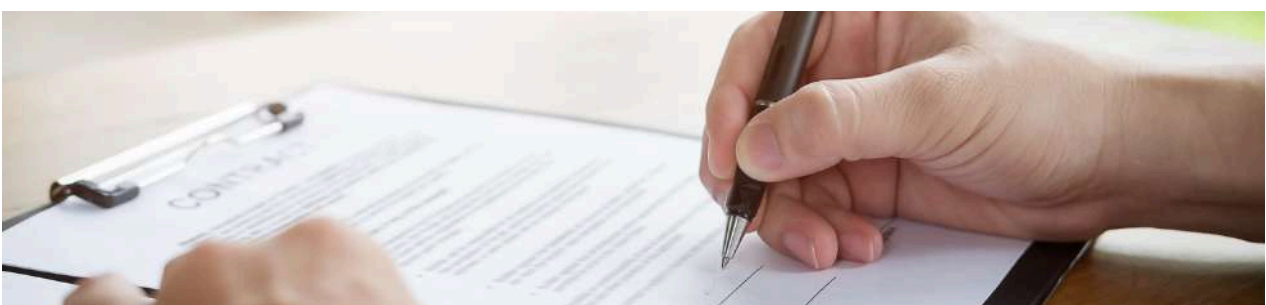


Mandoulides School
