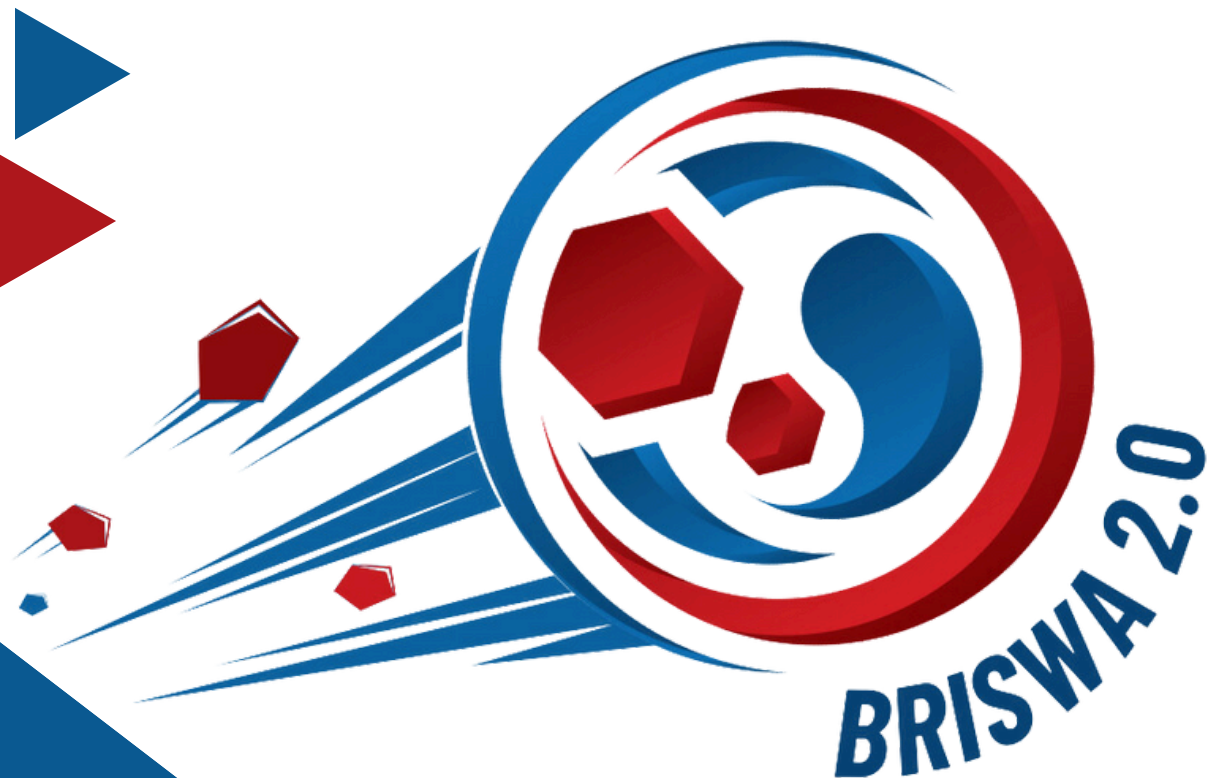

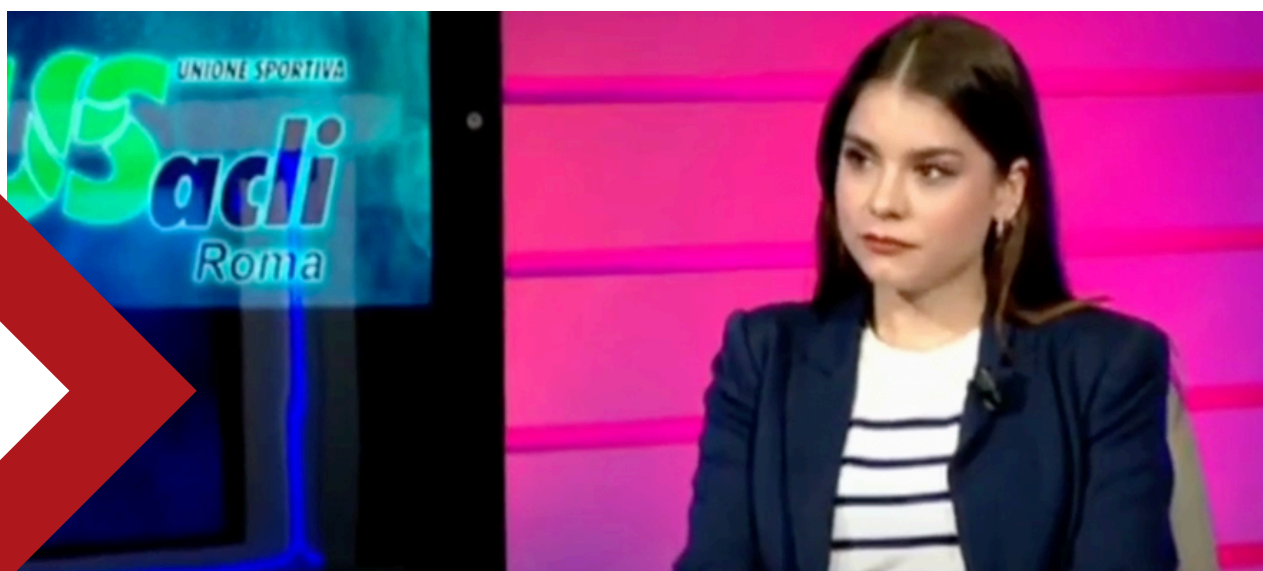

# Multiplier Event at Link Campus University



On **13 May**, the BRISWA 2.0 Multiplier Event was held at **Link Campus University** in **Rome**. The event, a collaboration between Link Campus University and SYDIC, explored the topic of **sustainability at 360 degrees**, highlighting how the different projects they are involved in are aligned with the EU Sustainable Development Goals.
